Applicants must currently work within a retail environment and should have relevant retail experience (one year full-time or part-time equivalent) AND one of the following:

- A Grade D3 in ordinary level English, Mathematics and three other subjects of the Leaving Certificate Examination (or approved equivalent), OR

  b. Holders of a full QQI Level 5 Award, OR

  Those who have completed the LYIT Preparatory Studies for Higher Education Programme, OR
- d. Mature Students i.e. over 23.
